

Bass Clarinet and Piano Consortium Agreement

By purchasing one of the Consortium Packages, you agree to the following:

- You are entitled to one year of exclusive performance rights of the new work (June 1, 2023 to May 31, 2024), shared with the other consortium members.
- You agree not to share the sheet music you receive with anyone else, other than with pianists you perform with.
- You agree that the Composer (Jonathan Russell) retains all intellectual property rights to the composition.
- As long as the piece is completed on time to the agreed upon specifications (a 15-20 minute work for bass clarinet and piano), you may not request any refunds, even if you don't like the piece and/or never perform it.
- If the composition is *not* delivered by the deadline of June 1, 2023, or does *not* meet the agreed upon specifications, you are entitled to a full refund of your purchase.
- You agree to notify the composer in advance of any plans to perform the work within the period of exclusivity (June 1, 2023 to May 31, 2024), and grant the Composer permission to publicize your performance(s) as they see fit.
- If a recording is made of your performance (audio or video), you are strongly encouraged to share it with the Composer.
- While it is encouraged that you perform the work during the period of exclusivity (June 1, 2023 to May 31, 2024), you are not required to do so.
- After May 31, 2024, you are free to perform the work as you like, but no longer retain any exclusivity to it.
- If you have purchased the Gold or Platinum packages, you agree to respond to communications about scheduling your 60-minute Zoom session(s) in a timely manner. If you fail to respond to reasonable efforts by the composer to schedule a session, this will *not* be considered a breach of contract by the Composer.
- If you have any questions or concerns about the process, you agree to address them forthrightly and respectfully with the Composer.
