* NOTES: The contra-alto and contra-bass parts are the same, so either one or both instruments may be used, at the ensemble's discretion. If no E♭ clarinet is available, it may be replaced by the included "B♭ Clarinet 0" part. If no alto or contra clarinets are available, they may be replaced by the included "Bass Clarinet 0" and "Bass Clarinet 3" parts, respectively.
